Time and Place:

Home sites of higher seeds on May 17, 2012, at 4:00pm
West Valley High School in Yakima on May 19, 2012. First games start at 10:00am.

Admission Prices:

1. Single Game Sessions: Adults - \$5.00 Students - \$4.00 (Gr. 7-12 w/ASB) – May 17
2. Two or more games: Adults - \$6.00 Students - \$4.00 (Gr. 7-12 w/ASB) – May 19
3. High School students must present a valid ASB card otherwise they must pay adult prices.
4. Senior Citizens will be admitted at student prices.
5. League and Golden Age passes WILL NOT be honored.
6. School Board – Complimentary School Board member passes will be honored.
7. Gates will be open at least 45 minutes before game time.

Conduct of Students, Community and School Personnel:

1. The Principal/Supervisors of each high school is responsible for the conduct of his/her students and the adult community.
2. Each participating high school is expected to furnish staff supervision for its' cheering section
3. Game Supervision Pass List must be **faxed** to the site manager.

District Program:

1. Zillah High School is responsible for the programs for the tournament.
2. Team Rosters for District Program due by Tuesday, May 15th or earlier if possible.

Team Benches/Warm-up:

The tournament manager will assign team benches.

Tournament:

The tournament will be an eight-team, double-elimination tournament. **THREE** teams will qualify for the state tournament as per the allocations in the state guidelines. The top place finisher will be the District 5 Champion.

Banners

Pep banners, signs (other than one official school banner), confetti and mechanical noisemakers (including band instruments used as noise makers) are not to be permitted at the tournament.

Radio Broadcasting

The charge for radio broadcasting is \$60.00 per day per tournament, regardless of the number of games broadcast.

Tournament Game Officials

The Tournament Manager will make specific game assignments from the block of officials assigned to each tournament date. Tournament managers will NOT alter assignments in response to requests from coaches or school administrators.
