District Allocations All varsity teams (maximum of 6 golfers) will qualify for district tournament and league schools without enough golfers to field a team for league matches may bring up to 3 boy and 3 girl golfers to the district tournament.

State Allocations 15 Boys, 7 Girls.

Coaching Coaching may occur between the completion of a hole and the next tee box.

Galleries They are permitted, but must remain in rough areas or on chart paths. All spectators are to keep 50 feet from competitors and observe the etiquette of golf. (Marshalls have the right to control galleries.)

Pace of Play An appropriate pace of play is an essential element of golf. To maintain fairness of competition for the group as well as those playing behind your group, players are required to maintain a reasonable pace of play. To assist a struggling golfer, the double par x scoring rule will be allowed, and will apply towards determining district team championship. **However, a double par x score on any hole will disqualify that player from qualifying to the state tournament.**

Marshalls Course Marshalls (aka Markers) will be distributed across the course, and will not be assigned to each group. Marshalls may be used clarify options for golfers and to record or relay concerns to the Rules Official or Tournament Director.

Seeding Coaches shall email the Tournament Director by Friday May 13, 2011 a ranked list of their golfers for each team. Additionally, coaches need to assign an average score for each golfer for seeding purposes.

Scoring Golfers will keep each other's score within the foursome. The Tournament Director will not accept scorecards unless they are signed by both the individual player and his/her scorer. Penalty for unsigned scorecards is automatic disqualification.

Lateral Hazards We shall play all natural area fairway boundaries as Lateral Hazards. You may play your ball if found, but you can't ground your club or move debris within the natural area. Natural areas are defined as not mown areas bordering the fairways. Please do not play a "Provisional Ball" because it will count as the ball in play. Provisional Balls may only be played when your ball is either potentially lost or out of bounds.

Awards Presentation will take place after the last group has finished play and all scores are totaled for each gender.

Ties/Disputes

In the event of a tie for 1st Place (Medalist), or for a state birth or alternate there will be a sudden death playoff beginning at the 1st tee. It will be under the direction of the tournament manager. The course pro will serve as arbitrator in all questions involving rules.

Dress Code

For the entire match, participants will wear collared shirts and slacks/hemmed shorts. No denim shorts allowed. Player will be disqualified if dress code is violated at any time during the match. Hats are to be worn in conventional manner.

Practice Rounds

Monday, May 16th is available for practice rounds at \$20/player. Coaches golf cart available for \$30/cart. Please call one week in advance to set up practice rounds.
